

Most of you have received our Stewardship letter and the new budget for 2019.

This is a 19% increase in our overall budget for 2019 but it is not a 19% increase in our operating budget. The increase in our overall budget is a result of including our assessed Apportionments for 2019 into our church operating budget. It has been a number of years since we have included our Apportionments that are a part of our commitment to the Minnesota Annual Conference into our Operating Budget so it seems like a large increase but in reality it is only showing our total budget needs in one budget instead of separating our Operational Budget and our Apportionments.


